Agri-Business Child Development (ABCD), founded in 1946, is committed to providing the highest quality early childhood education and social services to farm worker and other eligible families across New York State.

With thirteen (13) Centers located in areas of highest farm worker family concentrations, ABCD ensures a safe, nurturing place for children enabling New York State's agricultural community to recruit and retain a high-quality reliable workforce.

"The mission of Agri-Business Child Development is to support New York State agriculture by providing comprehensive early childhood education services to the children of eligible families."

What We Do...

The comprehensive services provided at Agri-Business Child Development Centers include:

Education Services

Areas of focus include: language development, literacy, mathematics, science, creative arts, social and emotional development, individualization, physical health and development, problem-solving, reasoning and initiative.

Family Engagement

Parents, the most important influence on a child's development, play an essential role in planning and decision-making for the program. Family engagement is highly regarded as key to a child's success.

Health Services

Every enrolled child receives age appropriate physicals and screenings. Children and families are linked with community resources to ensure access to continuous affordable health care.

Disabilities Services

With an emphasis on the partnership between families, center staff, and early intervention professionals, strategies are developed to provide individualized services that meet the unique needs of children with disabilities.

Nutrition Services

Prepared onsite, meals (breakfast, lunch and a snack) are carefully planned with a qualified nutrition consultant to assist children in meeting their nutritional needs.

Community Partnerships

Collaborations with community organizations enable families to connect with resources and support services.

Who We Serve...

Children, 8 weeks old through school age, receive services in thirteen (13) centers.

Eligibility for the Migrant and Seasonal Head Start program, as well as for services for local agricultural workers, is based on household income and employment status.

In addition to Migrant and Seasonal services, ABCD provides Early Head Start services to children eight weeks through three years of age as well as pre and post natal services to pregnant women in Orange County.

ABCD also provides Head Start services to eligible children from three years old until school age in Seneca County.

Eligibility for the Head Start and Early Head Start programs is based on household income.
